Answer the questions using this score sheet

After you finish, add up the A's and B's in each column.

For column 1, if you have more A's than B's, put E (Extrovert) in the last row. If you have more B's, put I (Introvert).

For column 2, if you have more A's, put S (Sensing). Otherwise put N (iNtuitive).

For column 3, if you have more A's, put F (Feeling). Otherwise, put T (Thinking).

For column 4, if you have more A's put J (Judging). Otherwise put P (Perceiving).

Now you have your personality type, for example ISTP (Introverted, Sensing, Thinking, Perceiving)! Let's find out what career is best for you!

Note: This is just for fun. This test is not a real Myers-Brigg test and was designed for ESL classes, not as a real psychological tool for analyzing personalities. I am a teacher, not a psychologist.
